**SOUTH BAY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD RECEIVES LOCAL  
COORDINATION INCENTIVE AWARD OF \$60,000.**

The South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) has been awarded a Local Coordination Incentive Award of \$60,000 by virtue of the wide range of services provided to local businesses by its business resource network. The award presented to SBWIB by Barbara Halsey, Executive Director of the California Workforce Investment Board, recognizes efforts coordinated locally by the SBWIB to improve upon the state's workforce investment system.
