

**South Bay Workforce Investment Board
Awarded Two Important Grants for Dislocated Workers.**

The purpose of these Grants is to enhance statewide workforce development efforts addressing emerging labor needs within the regions petrochemical, advanced manufacturing, food processing and aerospace industries.

The **South Bay Energy Grant** serves the pool of dislocated workers including machinists, mechanics, technicians, and others with specialized training applicable to other industries. At the same time, major employers in the refining, infrastructure, manufacturing, and food processing industries have identified a strong need for workers with related skills including industrial electricians, instrumentation technicians and machinist/millwrights.

The **SCAIP Grant** funding will allow the SBWIB to provide services and training to dislocated workers in aerospace and aviation to upgrade their skills to transition to a variety of high wage, high demand occupations in industries such as Health Care, Biotechnology, and Business and Professional Services.
