YES YOUTH CAN! - SUMMER YOUTH JOBS 2009 - APPLICATION PROCESS**

The South Bay Workforce Investment Board receives federal funds under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 and the Workforce Investment Act to provide summer job opportunities to low-income youth with barriers, age 14 – 24. In order to participate in Summer Youth Jobs 2009 youth must meet the following guidelines and complete the application process steps listed below.

**STEP 1 – YOUTH MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING GUIDELINES**

- Reside in the city of Inglewood, Hawthorne, Lawndale, El Segundo, Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach or Manhattan Beach
- Have the right to work in the U.S.
- Provide all required enrollment documents
- Meet income guidelines as shown below

The following income guidelines are measured for six months prior to enrollment and are based on the income for all who reside in the household:
