South Bay Workforce Investment Board Helps Launch Inglewood Unified School District's First Annual College & Career Fair for High School Students

HAWTHORNE – The South Bay Workforce Investment Board (SBWIB) partnered with the Inglewood Unified School District (IUSD) to present the first annual District-wide College and Career Fair for high school juniors and seniors that was held at the Beckmen Youth Orchestra Los Angeles (YOLA) Center in Inglewood November 16, 2022.

More than 1,000 students from Inglewood High School, Morningside High School, City Honors International Preparatory High School and Inglewood Continuation High School met with college recruiters and SBWIB partner vocational training providers including So Cal Regional Occupation Center, American Aerospace Technical Academy and Career Expansion who provided information on careers and apprenticeship opportunities in Construction, Non-Destructive Testing and other industries. Special breakout sessions were also conducted so students could learn about career pathway employment opportunities from representatives from Northrop Grumman, SoFi Stadium and AECOM.

Among the participating colleges and universities were UCLA, USC, Loyola Marymount, CSU Long Beach, El Camino College, West LA College, Washington State, University of Alabama and the National Association of Historically Black Colleges and Universities Students and Alumni.

“We very excited to be included in the planning and staging of this very successful career fair with the Inglewood Unified School District and look forward to continuing this very significant event for the benefit of all the students,” said SBWIB Executive Director Jan Vogel.

The SBWIB operates four One-Stop Centers to serve adult and youth job seekers in Inglewood, Hawthorne, El Segundo, Gardena, Carson, Manhattan Beach, Lawndale, Hermosa Beach, Torrance, Redondo Beach and Lomita.
