**Inglewood Unified School District Partners With
South Bay Workforce Investment Board to Present
Second Annual College and Career Fair**

HAWTHORNE – More than 1,000 high school and middle school age students were able to interface with college recruiters and representatives from public agencies, private businesses, and industries at the second annual College and Career Fair presented October 8th by the Inglewood Unified School District in partnership with the South Bay Workforce Investment Board at the Beckmen Youth Orchestra Center in Inglewood.

Students were also able to attend specialized workshops geared to informing them how to prepare and qualify for college, as well as sessions covering occupations presented by a variety of businesses and public agencies including Pfizer Pharmacies, the FBI, South Bay Lakers, LA County Department of Public Health, Inglewood Police Department, and West Basin Municipal Water District.

“This has become one of our most successful programs for exposing our youth to educational opportunities and exciting career fields,” said SBWIB Executive Director Jan Vogel. *“We look forward to future collaborations with our Inglewood school partners,”* he concluded.
